Remember: Carbs=starch=sugar; *high sugar is a leading cause of diabetes and some cancers.*

The formula to determine the percent of carbs in your pets' food is:

100% minus % of protein; minus % of fat; minus % of moisture; minus % of ash (assume 6% if not listed) equals % of carbs.

Example 1 (Blue Buffalo Chicken Dog Food)

100%-24% protein, -14% fat, -10% moisture, -6% ash = 46% CARBS

Example 2 (Blue Buffalo "Grain Free" Dog Food)

100%-22% protein, -12% fat, -10% moisture, -6% ash= 50% CARBS

(Disclaimer: I used Blue Buffalo in my example as it was the dog food I was using.)
